Greetings,

Thank you for your interest in the trips I lead to Brazil for healing with the miraculous medium João de Deus, John of God. I am writing to inform you about scheduling and other specifics.

It is a privilege to be of service to those seeking healing from John of God. He is world renowned for his documented paranormal healing ability. This dedicated man has spent 54 years healing thousands of people weekly as full trance medium who incorporate St. Ignatius Loyola and other highly evolved spirits that perform spiritual healing. His work is free of charge and no one is ever turned away.

I am Brazilian/English, fluent in Portuguese, and lived for 30 years on a ranch just 200 miles from Abadiânia. I am well versed with the customs and traditions of the people in this area and have forged wonderful supportive relationships with the Casa and hotel staff. This region is my soul's home and I would love to share its beauty with you. I will personally facilitate all aspects of the trip while we are in Brazil including translation, food and lodging, ground travel and spiritual counseling. The continued guidance and support I receive from the Casa family, the

Entities, and John of God has shown me how my background and skills have prepared me for this sacred work.

2012 Tour Costs

Two-week tours are \$1750; one-week tours are \$1450. Two-week tours start on a Monday and end on the second Saturday. Within this trip period, one-week tours are available. Come the first Monday (of the two-week trip) and leave on Sunday or arrive in Abadiânia on Sunday (the middle of the two-week trip) and leave on the following Saturday with the group.

There are a few single rooms available for each tour at the additional cost of \$350. You must check about single room availability as we process this on a first come, first served basis. If interested, please include a separate check for the single supplement when you send in your deposit payment. If a single room is available, the supplemental check will be applied.

Payment Procedures: How to secure a space for a tour

I require a \$500 deposit to reserve your space in any of the tours (\$300 non-refundable). Once deposit is received, the application packet shall be emailed to you.

The schedule for payment of the balance for each tour is as follows: December 16, 2011 for the January trip; February 26 for the March/April trip; May 11 for the June trip; September 14 for the October trip.

Both checks (deposit and balance) are to be made out to: Healing Quests LLC

(Priority mail with delivery confirmation is acceptable and may bring you comfort.)

In the memo of the check please write “John of God/Date (the actually date of your tour and be sure in include 1 or 2 weeks. The next step is to send an email with subject heading “[Confirmation for Trip](#)” when you mail in your deposit. In the email text include the following information:

- Date of the tour you will be attending and if it is for 1 or 2 weeks
- Your contact information: phone, email, and mailing address
- Your name as it appears on your passport
- Your passport number

Upon receipt of your email an application packet will be emailed to you. The packet includes:

- Cover letter with instructions, including on how to fill out the Brazilian Visa form
- A single page application
- A state of health form (must be notarized)
- A release form (must be notarized)

Please return the trip application, by scanning to email or sending regular mail, soon after receiving. Please return the notarized forms at the final payment due date.

You can find a notary (for health and release forms) at your local bank.

You may use USPS priority mail to send the documents to Barbara Conetta, 36 Janes Lane, Stamford, CT 06903. This will allow you to track the mailing if it does not arrive at Barb’s address.

Please note that your application will not be processed until all forms are completed and received. If you are sending forms and payment AFTER your tour’s deadline, then you must FedEx the forms and payment- DO NOT USE certified mail or any other service that requires signature confirmation. Please waive signature confirmation for FedEx else the packet will be returned to you.

Airfare, Visa, Reservations for Naoum Plaza

Please note that as of September 2009 the Brazilian Consulate has mandated that all visa forms must be completed online. If you decide to use Travel Visa Pro, which is included in our packet, follow their directions on how to complete visa process. Fill out the application, state of health and release forms and return them to Barbara.

My travel agent, Ana Luisa Walsh, at Discover Brazil Tours in Miami Florida, specializes in discount fares to Brazil and is well versed with the appropriate routes and arrival times into Brasilia. Her direct phone line (305) 382-9443, cell (786) 347-8834 or office (800) 524-3666 and her email is analuisa@discoverbraziltours.com. Tell her you are interested in Heather Cumming’s Abadiânia-Brasilia tour and provide your trip dates. If Ana Luisa is unavailable please ask for Eliane and her email is eliane2014@gmail.com. If there is a need to call on a weekend, please use her mobile: 305 632-3592.

If you choose to book your own airfare, your arrival and departure times must match those of the tour. We suggest that you arrive on the Sunday before the tour begins but if you choose to arrive

on Monday, you must arrive in the morning on or before 10:30am. **If you arrive later than Monday morning, you will have to pay for your own transportation to Abadiânia, the cost is approximately 180 Brazilian Reais each way.**

For departure, you should try for a Saturday morning or evening flight. Heather will arrange for morning and/or afternoon transportation from Abadiânia to Brasilia. For those flying later than Saturday, reservations will be made at the Naoum Plaza in Brasilia.

Travel to Brazil from the United States requires a tourist visa: however if you have a non-US passport (for those who have dual citizenship) you may not be required to obtain a tourist visa. Please check with your local Brazilian Consulate for visa requirements and processing fees. If there is no Consulate in your area you may use a visa service. I recommend Travel Visa Pro: Our contact is Mr. Kestutis Gregeris and you can email or call him toll free (888) 470-8472 ext. 712, if you are in San Francisco area his direct line is (415) 200-4561, and his email is kestutis@travelvisapro.com. Once you receive our application packet for the tour, it will include information on how to apply for the tourist visa- also a copy of the visa form. Travel Visa Pro offers expedited service, a visa in 3-4 days, at an additional fee- their normal fee is for a visa obtained within the normal 7-10 business day range. **Remember that should you choose to use Travel Visa Pro you still MUST APPLY FOR VISA online with the Brazilian Consulate in your area.**

For those travelers who would like a chance to rest before the two-week tours begin, we can arrange for you to arrive a day early (Sunday) and spend the night at a Five-star hotel in Brasilia, The Naoum Plaza. My groups receive a discounted rate that includes a lovely buffet breakfast Monday morning. If you choose this option, you will take cab from Brasilia airport (10 minutes) to the hotel (about 45 Brazilian Reais). I will email you a reservation number for the hotel and you will pay them directly with a credit card

I will pick you up from the hotel or the Airport on Monday morning when the tour begins. There will be more information emailed to you approximately one week before you travel.

Two-week tour: 12 nights, \$1750; One-week tour: 6 nights, \$1450.

Trip cost includes:

1. Introductions to the Entity and personal translation at all times.
Heather is your guide and translator and is fluent in Portuguese, French and Spanish. She was born on a ranch in the region, lived there for 30 years, has a deep understanding of the customs and mores of the region.
2. Hotel accommodation, based on double occupancy (single occupancy extra when available), and all meals at the hotel
3. Round trip ground transportation Brasilia to/from Abadiânia with Heather
4. Tour of village; local market and shops with translation
5. Taxis to and from sacred waterfall
6. One box of Holy Water
7. One Crystal Bed session
8. Generous donation to the Casa
9. Participation in optional evening programs conducted by Heather: orientation, meditations and prayer circle

Also included:

1. Guided day tour of Brasilia; the capital and its sacred sites (also included in Monday-to-Sunday one-week tour)
2. Visit to Temple of Good Will (home of one of the largest crystals in the world) to walk the labyrinth
3. Visit to a reputable jeweler specializing in Brazil's precious stones and gold jewelry
4. Brazilian "churrasco" lunch (barbeque)
5. Photographs for Surgery (taken at The Casa)

Not included:
